Subject: Admission matter of KKC Homoeopathic Medical College, 1-52, KKC Nagar, Prameswara Mangalam, Puttur-517584, Andhra Pradesh with 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2020-21-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats of KKC Homoeopathic Medical College, 1-52, KKC Nagar, Prameswara Mangalam, Puttur-517584, Andhra Pradesh, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 3406 dated 28.10.2020 as under:-

“Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of only 60 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course due to absence of Part time teachers of Modern Medicine and without any Prof. in 05 subjects (Anatomy, Physiology, Pharmacy, FMT, Surgery) either in Full time or in Guest cadre and deficient info on college website.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that the payment of teachers are not being paid online or through bank and college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.”

2. The college was granted an opportunity of hearing through Video-Conferencing to present their case on 07.11.2020. The college authority submitted the compliance report.

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, **conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to KKC Homoeopathic Medical College, 1-52, KKC Nagar, Prameswara Mangalam, Puttur-**

517584, Andhra Pradesh for continuing admissions in BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 100 seats, with the condition to fulfil all deficiencies as reflected at "para 1" by 31st December, 2020.

3. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

5. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

6. Further, the College shall comply the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2020 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
