Sub: Permission matter of KKC Homoeopathic Medical College, 1-52, KKC Nagar, Prameswara Mangalam, Puttur, Andhra Pradesh with intake capacity of 100 seats in undergraduate course (BHMS) for the academic year 2022-23- reg.

Sir,

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has received online application (Part-1) seeking permission for student intake in Under Graduate (BHMS) course with student intake of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23.

2. As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MA&RBH) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform that Part-1 Performa and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations.

3. On scrutiny and careful consideration of your documents and further observations of the Board, the following shortfalls to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) and PG Course [MD(Hom.)] course for the academic year 2022-23:

A. Hospital Facility: Average patients attended OPD during the last one year is 105.09. Average bed occupancy per day is 15.22% against requirement of 30%. In view of recent Covid-19 situation the factual position of OPD and IPD data for the last one is not considered for permission matter. However, this data as per sub-regulation (7) of MSR, 2013 need to be examined. Since Covid-19 and its epidemic situation has been improved, it is expected that IPD/OPD attendance of Collegiate Hospital also to be significantly improved. College may submit a compliance report on the activities taken by the college for improvement of OPD/IPD after 3 months from date of issue of this letter.

B. Teaching Staff: Affidavits of teachers such as Dr. George Felix J (Associate Professor, Dept. of Organon), Dr. Vasudevan K R (Associate Professor, Dept. of Surgery), Dr. Hemachandran T D (Associate Professor, Dept. of Community Medicine) and Professor, Dept. of Practice of Medicine is not submitted for verification. This may be furnished within a period of one week.

4. The applicant has set up the Homoeopathic Medical College and teaching Hospital with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to fulfill the above requirements for conducting Under Graduate course in Homoeopathy. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course.

5. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 the conditional permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for continuing admission is granted to KKC Homoeopathic Medical College, 1-52, KKC Nagar, Prameswara Mangalam, Puttur – 517584, Andhra Pradesh with intake capacity of 100 seats in undergraduate course (BHMS) for the academic year 2022-23.


6. The College Principal is directed to fulfill all deficiencies within a period of 3 months and an undertaking shall be submitted in this regard from the Controlling Authority of the College within a period of 07 days from issue of this letter of conditional permission.

7. All admissions in Under Graduate (BHMS) course shall be through 'National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET). Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy as per rules and the penalty as decided will be imposed.

8. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State / UT. 100% Under Graduate & Post Graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota for Deemed University as they are All India in nature. The Counseling of seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government.


9. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.
